Chris Kokoruda, Assistant County Attorney, Miami-Dade County, inquired regarding whether registration fees for an out-of-town conference paid by a JHS contractor could be accepted by a JHS employee, where the actual travel expenses would be paid for by JHS. I informed Mr. Kokoruda that, pursuant to Section 2-11.1(w) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance, such conference registration fees are considered to be a travel-related expense where the conference in question is held outside of the area and involves travel of some kind, even where the travel expenses themselves are paid by the County or by JHS.
