Darcee:

You have inquired regarding whether you may represent a current City of North Miami Beach official in connection with a matter that may be heard before the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust. I have reviewed Section 2-11.1(q) of the County Ethics Code, and I have determined that it would apply only in the context of your lobbying before an officer, employee or board of the City of North Miami Beach. Inasmuch as the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust is not a City of North Miami Beach board or committee, as well as the fact that representation at a quasi-judicial proceeding (which would apply to a proceeding before the Commission on Ethics) is generally exempted from the lobbying ordinance, Section 2-11.1(s), you would not be prohibited by the Ordinance from engaging in such representation.
