Dear Mr. Manduley:

You inquired whether the County Ethics Code would prohibit a County department from accepting equipment donations from CISCO Systems, Inc., a County vendor. You advise that Cisco has offered to donate equipment to the County under its technology adoption program which provides for donation of equipment to possible users. You also advise that CISCO's offer of donation does not include either an express or an implied obligation to purchase CISCO equipment.

The County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (e)(2)(e) allows the County to accept gifts "for use solely by the County in conducting its official business." The Ethics Commission has also found in previous opinions that the Ethics Code does not prohibit the County from accepting donations from a County Vendor as long as *no quid pro quo* exists as a condition of the donation and as long as the donation is used for an official purpose and not for the personal gain of County employees. See generally RQO 02-70 and INQ 07-69.

Consequently, as long as CISCO is making the donation without any expectation of any favorable action in return for the donation, this gift may be accepted. Equally important, because your department interacts with CISCO, you and your staff must be vigilant in not extending any special advantages or benefits to CISCO in response to this donation.

You may wish to document receipt of the gift with a letter to CISCO explaining that the County Ethics Code allows acceptance of the donation as long as *no quid pro quo* arrangement is envisioned.

This opinion is based on the facts presented. If these facts change, please contact me.

Per your request, I am attaching the bill of materials for what we are proposing to donate to the County. Please let me know if you would like to set up a time to review the details.






