Matt Haber, Assistant City Attorney for the City of Miami, inquired whether if the Miami City Commission were to effect a waiver of Section 2-11.1(w) of the County Ethics Code, which prohibits municipal or county officials and employees from accepting travel or travel-related expenses from City vendors, contractors or service providers, would also waive the gift reporting requirement in Section 2-11.1(e)(4) of the Code. I informed him that it would not, and that an official who accepted a gift pursuant to the waiver would have to disclose the gift under (e)(4) if it was in excess of \$100. I also informed him that the waiver would not effect a waiver under City of Miami Code Section 2-613 which prohibits similar gifts unless given for the use and benefit of the City.
