Dear Mr. Haber:

You have inquired whether you are required to file financial disclosure for the 2015 reporting year. You were employed as an Assistant City attorney for the City of Miami until March 2015.

The Miami-Dade Code at Sections 2-11.1(i) (1) and (2) require Assistant City Attorneys to file no later than 12:00 noon of July 1st of each year **including the July 1st following the last year that person is in office or held such employment**, one (1) of the following:

a. A copy of that person's or firm's current federal income tax return; or

b. A current certified financial statement on a form of the type approved for use by State or national banks in Florida listing all assets and liabilities having a value in excess of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and a short description of each; or

c. An itemized source of income statement, under oath and on a form approved by the County for said purpose. Compliance with the financial disclosure provisions of Chapter 112 (Part III), Florida Statutes, as amended, or with the provisions of Article II, Section 8 of the Florida Constitution, as amended by the voters on November 2, 1976, and any general laws promulgated thereunder, shall constitute compliance with this section.

Assistant City Attorneys generally file the County Source of Income Statement with their respective Municipal Clerk unless their job functions make them subject to State financial disclosure requirements (for example, purchase authority over \$20,000). Consequently, you would be required to file one of the above referenced financial disclosure documents by noon on July 1, 2016 reporting your sources of income during the time of your employment with the City of Miami in 2015.
