Dear Ms. Hire Miller,

You have inquired whether Rosario Fiallos, a Sr. Administrator with the County's Information & Technology Department (ITD), may accept a gift of a free training course she won in a drawing.

# Background

Ms. Fiallos participated in a survey sponsored by Informatica University (IU). IU is a company that provides inclass or online training, certification, products and other services focusing on data management for business needs. The survey was open to many customers of Informatica University and attendees at Informatica World (conference) as well. All survey participants were entered into a drawing for a free course of their choice (free seat, online course or learning subscription), valued from \$240.00 to \$3,200.00, depending on the course chosen. IU will run the course regardless of the prize awarded in the drawing. I have been informed that Ms. Fiallos is not a "procurement employee". I have also been informed that IU intends to transact business with the County in the next month by providing product training to ITD.

## Analysis

It is permissible for a County employee to participate in a survey where the County employee's name was entered in a drawing for a free course, provided the drawing was open to all customers, not just County employees. *See* INQ 11-04; INQ 11-163. The drawing in this case was open to all customers of the company, not just County employees, hence, Ms. Fiallos was permitted to participate.

Section 2-11.1(e) of the County Ethics Code prohibits the acceptance of gifts in consideration of some official action by a public servant. A gift won by chance and not obtained through the performance of an official duty does not present a conflict of interest. *See* INQ 12-162. (State law at Section 112.3148, prohibits public servants who are "reporting individuals" or "procurement employees" from accepting gifts from vendors or lobbyists in excess of \$100.00. Ms. Fiallo's position does not fall within this provision.)

Consequently, the prize won in the drawing conducted by IU is considered a gift which may be accepted by Ms. Fiallos because it was won by chance and not awarded in exchange for any duty or act she might be involved with in her County position. *See* INQ 15-151; INQ 12-162; INQ 11-04. However, given that the value of the prize exceeds the \$100.00 threshold, Ms. Fiallo must file a gift disclosure form pursuant to Section 2-11.1(e)(4) of the County Ethics Code. *See* INQ 08-63; INQ 09-124; INQ 13-127; INQ 15-151. This opinion is based on the facts as you have presented them, predicated on the fact that the prize awarded <u>will</u> <u>not</u> involve traveling and/or travel expenses. Please contact us if these facts change. Inquiries regarding possible conflicts

with departmental directives should be addressed with your Department Supervisor. Inquiries regarding possible conflicts under State law should be directed to the Florida Commission on Ethics.

Here are the raffle details to see if your person can accept the prize.

Informatica University was asking for survey responses to help direct our training offering strategy, determine what types of training our clients prefer and receive the most value from, and solicit general feedback on what we do well – what we can do better.
