Mr. Fernandez:

You have inquired on behalf of Rebeca Sosa, Miami-Dade County Commissioner (DIST6) regarding whether she would have a voting conflict of interest under the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code in participating in or voting on Item 8N1(161730), which would authorize the Mayor to execute a construction access agreement between Miami-Dade County and the Miami-Dade County School Board for a roadway project to be completed in the area of the McArthur South School. This question arises due to Commissioner Sosa's full-time employment with the Miami-Dade Public Schools as a Teacher/Curriculum/Program facilitator at the Lindsey Hopkins Technical Center.

I have reviewed the item in question, and it does not appear to be in any way related to the Commissioner's position with MDCPS. As an employee of a governmental agency (MDCPS), Commissioner Sosa is not automatically prohibited from participating in or voting on matters affecting MDCPS under Section 2-11.1(d) of the Code unless she would stand to profit or be enhanced by the measure. Based upon my review of the item and my understanding of Commissioner Sosa's position in the School Distrcit, I do find that she would, in any way, profit or be enhanced by the item, and, therefore, she would not have a voting conflict of interest that would prevent her from participating in and voting on the item.
