Dr. Glenn Joseph inquired on behalf of City of Miami Gardens Councilman David Williams, who is a candidate for reelection to the Miami Gardens City Council, regarding whether Councilman Williams's acceptance of a \$250 campaign contribution from an entity that is taking over a building in Miami Gardens to provide a program there, would create a voting conflict of interest under Section 2-11.1(d) of the Ethics Code. If it would, then Councilman Williams would return the contribution. I advised that acceptance of a campaign contribution, by itself and assuming no quid pro quo involving any action to be taken by the Councilman, would not create a prohibited conflict of interest on a later vote taken by the Councilman on a matter affecting the entity that made the contribution. It does not create a prohibited relationship and there is no basis to conclude that the later vote would profit or enhance the official in a way that would violate the ordinance. However, I also advised that any elected official should use his or her judgement in deciding whether to accept or reject a contribution from a person or entity having an interest in business before the official's board, if he or she felt it would create an appearance of impropriety.
