Additionally, the City of North Miami Code Section 2-78, which prohibits lobbyists from making any non-nominal expenditure for the benefit of an elected official or employee of the City "for the purpose of lobbying," would not apply where the purpose of the gift is as a wedding gift and not for the purpose of lobbying.
