## Dear Ms. Milian,

You inquire whether a member of the Miami-Dade County Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board may apply for a Mom & Pop grant with the County.

As background, Jose Diaz is a member of the Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board. He is also the owner of a small business located in Miami-Dade County, District 6, to wit: Jamz Auto Club, Inc., which is a used auto dealership and car repair shop. Mr. Diaz would like to apply for a Mom & Pop grant through the Mom & Pop Small Business Grant Program. This County program provides financial and technical assistance to all qualified for-profit small businesses that are approved for funding.

There is no conflict of interest which prohibits a board member from applying for a County grant **provided** certain limitations are followed:

- 1) He may not make a presentation or appear before the Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board seeking a grant. See §2-11.1(m)(2), County Ethics Code; INQ 12-13
- 2) He may not vote or participate in any way on matters before the Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board that would affect his business, Jamz Auto Club, Inc. See § 2-11.1(v), County Ethics Code
- 3) He may not participate in any official action, directly or indirectly, affecting Jamz Auto Club, Inc. See 2-11.1(n), County Ethics Code
- 4) He is prohibited from exploiting his official position to secure special privileges or exemptions for himself or his business. *See* § 2-11.1(g), County Ethics Code
- 5) He is prohibited from disclosing confidential information acquired by reason of his official County position. See § 2-11.1(h), County Ethics Code
- 6) He may not serve on a County board that would enforce, oversee or administer a grant or contract for his for-profit business. *See* Sec. 2-11.1 (c) and (d), County Ethics Code

Consequently, Mr. Diaz may apply for and accept a grant on behalf of Jamz Auto Club, Inc., from the County's Mom & Pop Small Business Grant Program AS LONG AS Mr. Diaz has not attempted to influence an official decision to

benefit his for-profit business in any way. Please be advised that the County Ethics Commission has interpreted this prohibition very expansively to include any communications, in any form, intended to influence any individual within the County to take an official action. *See* INQ 12-13, INQ 11-01, INQ 10-201
