Gerald Sanchez, Assistant Miami-Dade County Attorney, inquired on behalf of a County Commissioner regarding whether a voting conflict would occur in connection with an upcoming item before the County Commission to ratify a contract with Security Alliance, LLC. The Commissioner in question is involved in the security business and is employed by a different security company. However, Mr. Sanchez made it clear that the Commissioner has no relationship whatsoever with Security Alliance and neither he nor the company that employs him has any interest in the contract being awarded. Under these circumstances, I advised that the Commissioner does not have a voting conflict and may participate an vote on the item in question, because the Commissioner does not have any of the relationships under Section 2-11.1(d) of the Ethics Code that could create a conflict, and because it does not appear that there is any chance that the Commissioner would or might, directly or indirectly, profit or be enhanced by that action on the contract.
