**Subject:** INQ 16-294 Tracy Truppman, Mayor, Village of Biscayne Park (Ethics Training)

Mayor Tracy Truppman, of the Village of Biscayne Park, inquired concerning the County and State of Florida ethics training requirements. She asked whether the State 4-hour course suffices for the County ethics training requirement in Section 2-11.1(bb). I informed her of the differences between the two requirements, that the State requires a 4-hour course every year that can be done by any qualified presenter, but the County ethics course, which is required only within 60 days of a local election, is usually only about two hours cannot be given by anyone other than the COE or a person specially designated by the COE. Therefore, although she has completed the four-hour State course, she will need to attend one of the upcoming County course to fulfill the County requirement.
