Flora,

I apologize for the delay in responding, but I just returned from vacation this week and have been fairly swamped.

You have inquired regarding whether there is an ethical prohibition regarding acceptance of a \$10 Starbucks gift card provided by a patient treated by MDFR paramedics, which were sent unsolicited to each person on the call. Based on the provisions of Section 2-11.1(e)(3) of the County Ethics Code, I would advise you not to distribute the cards to the employees and to return them to the sender, perhaps with a letter thanking that person for his/her thoughtfulness but explaining that it would be inappropriate for public servants in the County to accept gifts for services performed in the course of their duties. Section 2-11.1(e)(4) prohibits the acceptance of a gift for an official action taken by a County employee, which appears to be the case here. Further, Section 2-11.(k)(1) prohibits County employees from receiving any compensation for his or her services as a County employee from any source other than the County. Let me know if you have any questions.
