Dear Maggie:

It was a pleasure to speak with you over the phone. You inquired about requirements for ethics training for County board members and for County elected officials.

The County Ethics Code addresses ethics training for elected officials and employees in Section 2-11.1(bb) which states in relevant part:

"...Each elected official, as defined in subsection (b)(1) [Board of County Commissioners and Mayor], shall, within ninety (90) days after being sworn into office, submit to the Clerk of the Board a certificate of completion of an ethics course offered by the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust ("Ethics Course"). Each employee of the County, as defined in subsection (b)(5) and b(6), shall within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the effective date of this ordinance or within sixty (60) days after being hired by the County, submit to the Clerk of the Board a certificate of completion of an Ethics Course offered by the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust. Employees shall be required to complete a refresher Ethics Course every two years thereafter. Each employee who has completed a refresher Ethics Course shall submit to the Clerk of the Board a certificate of completion. The Ethics Course shall include, but not be limited to, a review of the following topics: the Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance; the Sunshine Law; the Public Records Law and the Citizens' Bill of Rights..."

The requirement for ethics training for County Board members is found in a separate resolution, RES 189-05(attached) which states:

"... the members of all County boards shall be required to complete an ethics training course which, at a minimum, shall include the following topics: the Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance; the Sunshine Law; and the Public Records Law. The ethics training course shall be developed by the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust ("Ethics Commission"). All current and future board members shall be required to complete the ethics training course pursuant to a schedule developed by the Ethics Commission..."
