Ms. Jacobs:

In response to your question about lobbyist training, we confirm that the County Ethics Code requires County lobbyists to: "within sixty days (60) days after registering as a lobbyist, submit to the Clerk of the Board a certificate of completion of an ethics course offered by the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and public trust." Miami-Dade Code § 2-11.1(s)(2)(d).

In this case, you advise that your client registered as a lobbyist on January 10, 2017 and cannot attend the February 24, 2017 live lobbyist training presented by the Ethics Commission. COE staff informs me that there will be a video lobbyist training on January 31 of this year. If your client wishes to attend that video training she would have to complete the lobbyist training registration form and send it Rodzandra Sanchez at : [Rodzandra.sanchez@miamidade.gov](mailto:Rodzandra.sanchez@miamidade.gov). If she is unable to attend the January 31st training, the March 17 course would exceed the 60 day requirement for ethics training set out in the County Ethics Code. You client would therefore not be in compliance with the Ethics Code and would be prohibited from lobbying until the ethics training is completed.
