The Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics & Public Trust is reaching out to residents, public employees, elected officials and politically active citizens in across Miami-Dade County with an “open house.”

Ethics Commission staff will explain the agency’s work and mission, give an overview of key provisions of the Ethics Code, briefly review Sunshine and Public Records Laws, make a presentation on the Citizens’ Bill of Rights and answer audience questions.
