PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Maria M. Estupinian (Estupinian) filed this complaint against Jessica Keller (Keller), Assistant Director of Public Works for the City of Coral Gables, alleging that Keller kept residents “in the dark” about a Florida Department of Transportation District VI Grant Application submitted on March 20, 2015.

A legally sufficient complaint exists where there are allegations of a violation of an ordinance within the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission, purportedly committed by an individual within the authority of the Ethics Commission, and filed with the Ethics Commission within three years of the alleged violation.

The complaint’s allegation took place in 2015, beyond the three-year statute of limitations.

On March 11, 2020, in closed session, the Ethics Commission’s General Counsel recommended that the case be dismissed. In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to find No Legal Sufficiency and dismissed the case.


Wherefore it is:
