PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The Advocate filed this Complaint against Respondent, James "Larry" Helms, National Business Development Manager for Motorola Solutions, Inc. (hereinafter "Motorola"), alleging that he violated Section 2-11.1(s) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance entitled "Lobbying."

Respondent failed to register to lobby *prior* to attending and lobbying Miami-Dade County officials and personnel during a negotiation meeting between Motorola and the County regarding a CAD system service supplemental agreement/extension, on or about September 18, 2019.

Respondent stipulated to a finding of probable cause to the allegation enumerated in the above referenced Ethics Complaint regarding section 2-11.1 (s) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance entitled, "Lobbying," and agreed to accept a Letter of Instruction.

On March 11, 2020, the Ethics Commission accepted the stipulation to probable cause and the settlement agreement, dismissed the case and ordered a Letter of Instruction to be issued.


Wherefore it is:
