PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Complainant, Laverne Deer (Deer), who was a candidate for City of Miami Gardens Mayor, filed this complaint against Oliver Gilbert (Gilbert) who was the former Miami Gardens Mayor but was subsequently elected to the Miami-Dade County Commission. Deer alleged that Gilbert violated Miami-Dade County's Ethical Campaign Practices Ordinance when he allegedly took Deer's campaign flyers out of the hands of a voter at North Dade K8 School, a polling place in Miami Gardens, during the August 18, 2020 primary and threw them on the ground.

On December 9, 2020 the Ethics Commission agreed with the Advocate's recommendation that the evidence was insufficient to support a finding of Probable Cause to proceed with the complaint and dismissed it.


Wherefore it is:
