Therefore, holding an event to benefit the United Way at Miami International Airport seems appropriate under the circumstances. Moreover, you aren't actually soliciting individuals per se – you are merely holding a garage sale and no individuals (employees or passengers) are obligated to make purchases to benefit the United Way.
