**Subject:** Inquiry

I received an e-mail and a phone call from Frank Irizarry – a member of Community Council 11. He indicated to me that is being asked to chair the local advocacy committee of the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce and has been nominated to sit on the Children's Trust. He inquired about whether either position creates a conflict of interest. I advised him that a conflict of interest does not exist if he chairs a committee of the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce. Obviously, if the committee made a recommendation that comes before Community Council 11, he might want to ask for another opinion. Secondly, members of the community councils are only restricted from working for the County or serving as County Commissioners. Therefore, he may be appointed to Children's Trust (as long as he is eligible per the Trust's enabling ordinance) and simultaneously serve on Community Council 11.
