Dear Mr. Meyers:

Immediately following my firm's hiring of Mr. Nick Mazorra (a former legislative aide to a County Commissioner), I sent you a March 23, 2001 request for an advisory opinion regarding the specific lobbying restrictions imposed on Mr. Mazorra by Section 2-11.1 (q) of the Code of Miami-Dade County. On April 5, 2001, you issued Advisory Opinion 01-38 describing such restrictions.

Mr. Mazorra resigned as an employee of Miami-Dade County on March 20, 2001. Accordingly, it is our understanding that, as it pertains to Mr. Mazorra, the County's "Two-Year Rule" imposing the lobbying restrictions in Miami-Dade County set-forth in Section 2-11.1 of the Code, and referenced in Advisory Opinion 01-38, will expire on March 20, 2003 (thirty 30 days from this date).
