Caryn:

I discussed the item you brought to my attention earlier in the week with our attorney and she and I agree that an appointed community council member may not be employed by the County. As a part-time hearing officer, I do not see that relationship as one of employer-employee. Rather, I see you as an independent contractor who would not be legally barred by the restrictions placed on council members. As far as any conflicts that could arise based on your role as a hearing officer and as a member of a community council, these cases would have to be handled individually. There could be an occasion where a conflict would be created, but that is likely to be the exceptional case. If you were faced with frequently recurring conflict, that would be another matter altogether.
