This division is responsible for ensuring compliance by county contractors with various ordinances including the Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Ord. 97-52 and the Responsible Wages & Benefits Ord. 90-143 as they apply to our construction contracts.

Their CSBE status expired 12/31/99 and they do not have any county contracts at this time.
