Name and Authority: The Judicial Circuit 11 Juvenile Justice Board which is established and given its authority by Section 985.4135, Florida Statutes, and is subject to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.

Purpose: The purpose of the Circuit Board is to provide advice and direction to the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice in the development and implementation of juvenile justice programs and to work collaboratively with the Department in seeking program improvements and policy changes to address the emerging and changing needs of Florida's youth who are at risk of delinquency.

Duties: The duties of the Circuit Board include but are not limited to the following:

1. To develop a comprehensive juvenile justice prevention and early intervention plan for the circuit;
2. To participate in facilitating interagency cooperation and information sharing;
3. To advise and assist the Department in the evaluation and award of prevention and early intervention grant programs, including the Community Juvenile Justice Partnership Grant program established in Section 985.415, Florida Statutes and the proceeds derived from the Invest in Children license plate annual use fees;
4. To apply for and receive public or private grants to be administered by one of the community partners that support one or more components of the circuit plan;
5. To provide an annual report to the Department describing the activities of the Circuit Board as per the format and content requirements prescribed by the Department;
