This investigative inquiry was predicated on a prior COE investigation, K09-071, involving a City of Miami demolition project whose vendor was the BG Group. It was alleged that the BG Group overbilled the City of Miami for demolition material disposal fees, for further information refer to the above cited COE case number.

On or about December 2010 the City of Sunny Isles Beach (The City) through its administrative arm requested three quotes from the demolition industry for the demolition and debris removal of a structure and parking lot located at 16200 Collins Avenue.

On January 20th 2011 the City entered into an agreement with the BG Group as contractor for the demolition project.

The demolition and subsequent debris removal has been completed to the City's satisfaction.

The COE reviewed all documents related to the project, finding no areas of concern similar to the K09-071 investigation. These documents have been made a permanent part of the investigative case file.

Therefore, after discussion with the Advocate, this investigation is closed without further action.
