Allegation:

The purpose of this investigation is to verify whether or not Miami-Dade County employees or family members who have registered as County Vendors, are in compliance with the provisions of opinions given by the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust.

Investigation:

The applicant in this matter is the wife of a Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue (MDFR) employee. The INQ dated May 5, 2011 states that **First Aid Services Of Florida, Inc.** can conduct business with any department except MDFR.

The Department of Procurement Management indices indicate that, **First Aid Services Of Florida, Inc.** is registered as a MDC vendor as of June 2011. There is no record of payments to this vendor.

COE Investigator contacted Gay A. Manzini (Manzini) and advised her of the above information. Manzini advised that her company offers first aid services at major events, such first aid stations where Band-Aids, OTCs, etc. are provided.
