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The COE was copied on a letter dated 09/18/14 from Michael Liu (Liu), Director of Miami-Dade County Public Housing and Community Development (PHCD) to PHCD employee Monica Perry (Perry). According to Liu, Perry, who resides in public housing, was promoted to the Assistant Director of Asset Management position on 06/17/13. The letter confirms that Perry was advised by her supervisor that there may be a conflict of interest in her new position should she remain in public housing. Furthermore, Liu advised Perry that he confirmed that the COE had advised her that there is a conflict of interest in her new position should she continue to reside in public housing. Lastly, Perry was notified by Liu that she must find alternate housing within 60 days or otherwise forfeit her position and/or face termination of her public housing subsidy.

On or about 12/10/14, this investigator spoke to Perry who advised that she had moved from her public housing residence located at 16204 N.W. 37<sup>th</sup> Place in Opa-Locka to a new residence located at 3227 N.W. 179<sup>th</sup> Street in Miami Gardens. Subsequently, an internet search was conducted which confirmed that Perry no longer resides at the public housing location and that her new address is 3227 N.W. 179<sup>th</sup> Street as was stated.
