PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Robert Jamieson filed the above-captioned complaint against several Miami-Dade Police officers for violation of Section 2-11.1(j) (misuse of official position) of the Conflict of Interest ordinance.

On December 28, 2004, Jamieson was arrested by the Miami-Dade Police Department. Jamieson was charged with unlawful battery, false imprisonment, impersonating a U.N. officer and resisting an officer without violence. Jamieson alleged the Respondents did not have grounds for an arrest and made false statements at his arraignment.

On June 23, 2005, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally insufficient because the allegations did not state a possible violation of an ordinance under the Ethics Commission's jurisdiction.


Therefore, it is:
