PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

COMPLAINANT, Robert C. Middaugh, Assistant City Manager of the City of Miami Beach, filed the above-captioned COMPLAINT against RESPONDENT Kelly Goeden, formerly a Code Compliance Officer with the City of Miami Beach, alleging violations of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance at Section 2-11.1 (g) *Exploitation of official position prohibited*. Specifically, the COMPLAINT alleged that, in and around the first quarter of 2005, RESPONDENT Goeden falsified daily route sheets to conceal non-work related activities he pursued instead of completing his City duties and that he presented false doctors' notes to the City to justify use of sick time.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County, Section 2-1068, the Commission on Ethics & Public Trust has jurisdiction to enforce the Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance, Section 2-11.1. On September 22, 2005, the Ethics Commission determined the COMPLAINT to be legally sufficient. On November 15, 2005, the Ethics Commission granted RESPONDENT's motion to stay proceedings until personnel proceedings at the City of Miami Beach were concluded. On May 25, 2006, the Commission on Ethics granted COMPLAINANT's motion to withdraw the

COMPLAINT, based on a settlement agreement entered into by the City of Miami Beach with Mr. Goeden terminating Mr. Goeden's employment with the City.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT the COMPLAINT is hereby dismissed.
