


SETTLEMENT ORDER

Pursuant to section 5.13 of the Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust Rules of Procedure, Petitioner and Respondent do hereby enter into this settlement in full satisfaction of the above captioned matter based upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Respondent, CLARENCE BIRD does hereby agree not to contest the allegations in counts II and III of Ethics Complaint C05-27 and agrees to pay a fine of \$750 (seven hundred and fifty dollars) and accept a written reprimand in full satisfaction of Ethics Complaint number C05-27.
2. The Advocate recommends as part of this negotiated settlement and considering that full restitution to Miami-Dade County has been made that Count I be dismissed.
3. Respondent agrees to the terms of this settlement agreement knowingly, freely and without duress.
4. Petitioner and Respondent agree that settlement of this action in the manner described above is just and in the best interests of Respondent and the citizens of Miami-Dade County.
