PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The ADVOCATE filed the above-mentioned COMPLAINT against RESPONDENT Jannie Beverly, City Manager of the City of Opa-Locka, alleging violations of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance at Section 2-11.1 (g) *Exploitation of official position prohibited*.

According to the allegations outlined in the COMPLAINT, Ms. Beverly implicitly acquiesced to the taking of City gasoline by the City Clerk for personal home use and, thereby, enabled, facilitated, and legitimized what appeared to be the City Clerk's improper behavior.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County, Section 2-1068, the Commission on Ethics & Public Trust has jurisdiction to enforce the Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics Ordinance, Section 2-11.1 (g). On May 25, 2006, the Ethics Commission determined the COMPLAINT to be legally sufficient. At the same time, the ADVOCATE moved that the COMPLAINT be dismissed for lack of probable cause, based on the Ethics Commission's dismissal of the related case against the City Clerk on April 27, 2006. The Ethics Commission granted the ADVOCATE's motion to dismiss for lack of probable cause.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT the COMPLAINT is hereby dismissed.
