**PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

Phillip Brutus filed the above-captioned complaint against Commissioner Dorrin Rolle ("Respondent") for alleged violation of Section 2-11.1(g) (misuse of official position). The complaint alleged the Respondent received favorable coverage on Haitian radio and TV stations that receive county funding.

On May 25, 2006, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally sufficient. Subsequently, the Advocate and the Respondent filed a joint motion for extension of time for the probable cause determination. On July 13, 2006, the Advocate made a no probable cause recommendation. On July 13, 2006, after reviewing the pleadings and being fully advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission found no probable cause and dismissed the above-captioned complaint.


Therefore it is:
