**PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

Jay Beskin filed the above-captioned complaint against Commissioner Sally Heyman ("Respondent") for alleged violation of Statement 11 (use of campaign material that falsifies, distorts or misrepresents facts) of the Fair Campaign Practices ordinance. The complaint arose out of a letter to the Neighbors section of the Miami Herald from Heyman regarding an article on Beskin. Heyman challenged certain of the statements regarding Beskin and his record. Beskin alleged that Heyman's letter mischaracterized his record.

On December 21, 2006, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally sufficient. Thereafter, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission found that the public interest would

not be served by further proceedings and ordered the complaint dismissed.

Therefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT** the Complaint is  
**DISMISSED.**
