**PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

The Advocate filed the above-captioned complaint against Traci Boyd ("Respondent") for alleged violation of Section 2-11.1(g) (misuse of official position). The complaint alleged the Respondent misused her official position by violating the internal work policies of the Human Services Department.

On March 22, 2007, the Advocate made a Motion to Dismiss, *ore tenus*, on the grounds that Respondent's counsel was unavailable and probable cause could not be determined within the time limit established by Section 2-1074 (a) (2) of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

On March 22, 2007, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission granted the Advocate's Motion to Dismiss without prejudice on the grounds that probable cause could not be

determined within the applicable time limits. Therefore it  
is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT** the Complaint is  
**DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.**
