PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Willie E. Currie filed the above-captioned complaint against Linda Goddard, Greg Garcia, Eduardo Ros and Jorge Curi ("Respondents ") for alleged violation of Section 2-11.1(g) (misuse of official position) for punching each other's time cards.

The complainant and the respondents are trainees in the Miami-Dade Transit Department. The complaint alleged the respondents punched each other's time cards. A surveillance camera that records such activity verified that the information contained on the time cards does not correspond to the pictures of the hours worked by the trainees.

On April 19, 2007 the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally insufficient because the complaint
