**PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

The Advocate filed the above-captioned complaint against Tucker Gibbs ("Respondent") for violation of Section 2-11.1(s) (Lobbying) for failing to pay the required late fees for filing his expenditure report after the due date.

In 2006, the Respondent registered as a lobbyist for Angelo Agreda. Pursuant to Section 2-11.1(s), the Respondent was required to file a lobbyist expenditure report on July 2, 2007. The Clerk of the Board sent the Respondent the courtesy reminders in May and June of 2007. The Clerk of the Board sent the Respondent a Notice of Violation on July 16, 2007. The Respondent filed his expenditure form on July 19, 2007. However, as of the date of the filing of the complaint, the Respondent has not filed an appeal or paid the required late fees.

On October 24, 2007, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally sufficient. On November 15, 2007, the

Advocate made a Motion to Dismiss, *ore tenus*, on the grounds that the Respondent had paid the applicable late fees.

On November 15, 2007, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission granted the Advocate's Motion to Dismiss on the grounds that the Respondent had paid the applicable late fees. Therefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT** the Complaint is **DISMISSED.**
