**PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

Susan Parker Fein filed the above-captioned complaint against Judge David Miller ("Judge"), Attorney Mark Antonelli and Johnson and Wales University ("University"). Fein is a plaintiff in a lawsuit against Johnson and Wales University. Respondent Antonelli is the University's counsel and the trial court proceedings were held in front of Judge Miller.

The complaint alleged Respondent Antonelli conspired with the University to bribe the Judge by depositing fifty thousand dollars into his re-election campaign account. According to the allegations in the complaint, the funds were listed on the Judge's campaign reports as a "personal loan" to his campaign. The complaint also alleged the case was steered to the Judge and was not assigned according to the blind filing system.

On February 27, 2008, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally insufficient because the Ethics Commission does not have jurisdiction over the Respondents. Thereafter, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission ordered the complaint dismissed. Therefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT** the Complaint is **DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction.**
