PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Joshua Hartnett filed the above-captioned complaint against Vartar Ananian ("Respondent") for violation of Section 2-11.1(e) (misuse of official position). The complaint alleged the Respondent used his official position to have his son hired at the airport.

The Respondent is Lead Technician at the Aviation Department Radio Services Division. The Respondent's son was hired as a trainee by an airport contractor and received training on radio systems at the Aviation Department. The complaint alleged the Respondent used his influence to have his son hired by the contractor.

On August 28, 2008, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally sufficient. Thereafter, after reviewing the Advocate's no probable cause recommendation and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission

dismissed the complaint for lack of probable cause.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT the Complaint is
DISMISSED for lack of probable cause.
