PUBLIC REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Alexis Ortega filed the above-captioned complaint against Sunpass, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) and Washington Group International. The complaint alleged the Sunpass system works improperly.

Ortega is a Sunpass user. According to the complaint, the Sunpass system improperly charged Ortega with violations. In April, 2008, after unsuccessfully trying to resolve the problems, Ortega discontinued his Sunpass account. However, the Sunpass system continued to charge Ortega's account with violations.

On December 3, 2008, the Ethics Commission found the complaint legally insufficient because the Ethics Commission does not jurisdiction over any of the parties. Thereafter, after reviewing the complaint and being otherwise advised in the premises, the Ethics Commission dismissed the complaint.

Therefore, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT the Complaint is
DISMISSED.
