PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The DEPUTY ADVOCATE for the Commission on Ethics filed the above-referenced COMPLAINT against RESPONDENT Sereda White for allegedly violating the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (i)(1). Specifically, the COMPLAINT claimed that RESPONDENT failed to file a financial disclosure statement for the year 2009 while serving on the City of Miami's Equal Opportunity Advisory Board. As a board member in 2009, she was required to file by July 1, 2010.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Sec. 2-1068, the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission extends "to any person required to comply with the County or municipal Code of Ethics Ordinances...."

On October 25, 2011, in public session, the DEPUTY ADVOCATE reported that RESPONDENT complied immediately to the financial disclosure requirement once she received adequate notice. Consequently, the Ethics Commission found that the public

interest would not be served by proceeding further in this matter and granted the DEPUTY ADVOCATE'S Voluntary Motion to Dismiss.¹


Therefore it is:
