PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Al Crespo, a private citizen, filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondents Marc Sarnoff, a City of Miami elected official; William Plascencia, a staff member of Commissioner Sarnoff; Javier Betancourt, Executive Director of the Miami Downtown Development Authority; and David Karsh, Communications Director of the Miami Community Redevelopment Agency. The complaint alleged that respondents violated Florida Statute 106.15 (3) by working on the reelection campaign of Commissioner Sarnoff during hours they were required to be performing their public duties.

Pursuant to the County Code at Sec. 2-1068, the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission does not extend to interpreting or enforcing State laws.

On December 16, 2011, Mr. Crespo withdrew this complaint after being advised that the violation did not fall within the jurisdiction of the County Ethics Commission.


Therefore it is:
