PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

An ethics complaint was filed against Respondent, City of Miami Commissioner Frank Carollo. The complaint alleged that Carollo violated Section 2-11.1 (g) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest by telephoning the city of Miami chief of police after being stopped for committing a traffic infraction. The chief contacted the area commander who in turn contacted the officer on the scene. Carollo was issued a warning by the officer but was not issued a citation.

On March 5, 2014, in open session, the Ethics Commission accepted Carollo's plea of No Contest. He was found to be in violation of one (1) count of Section 2-11.1(g) of the Miami-Dade County Conflict of Interest and Code of Ethics, ordered to pay a \$1,000.00 fine and \$1,404.15 in investigative costs within thirty (30) days. Carollo agreed to accept a Letter of Instruction.


Therefore it is:
