PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Edward MacDougall, the Mayor of the Town of Cutler Bay, filed the above-referenced complaint against respondents Jose Luis Castillo and Juan Mayol, lobbyists in the Town of Cutler Bay. The complaint alleged that respondents violated the Town of Cutler Bay Ordinance 07-02 when they failed to disclose meetings with Cutler Bay officials in 2012 and 2013 related to their client's application to develop a shopping center in the Town.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Secs. 2-1068 and 2-11.1 (a), the Ethics Commission is empowered to enforce the County and municipal Code of Ethics ordinances and to accept and enforce settlement agreements entered into by the advocate and respondents.

Respondents agreed that the allegations referenced in this complaint were supported by probably cause. They further agreed not to contest the charges against them and to enter into settlement agreements with the Ethics Commission.

On August 8, 2013, in public session, the Ethics Commission accepted the settlement agreements with Mr. Castillo and with Mr. Mayol. Pursuant to those agreements, each respondent accepted a Letter of Instruction from the Ethics

Commission, and each agreed to pay a \$250 fine. The Ethics Commission hereby enters the Final Settlement Agreements and attached Letters of Instruction as its Final Report and Order.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 13-02 against respondents Jose Luis Castillo and Juan Mayol is hereby concluded.
