**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

The DEPUTY GENERAL COUNSEL for the Commission on Ethics filed the above-referenced COMPLAINT against RESPONDENT Enrique Lopez for allegedly violating the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (i)(1). Specifically, the COMPLAINT claimed that RESPONDENT failed to file a financial disclosure statement for the year 2010 while serving on the City of Coral Gables Green Task Force. As a task force member in 2010, he was required to file by July 1, 2011.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Secs. 2-1068 and 2-11.1 (a), the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission extends “to any person required to comply with the County or municipal Code of Ethics Ordinances....”

On April 11, 2013, in public session, the DEPUTY GENERAL COUNSEL reported that RESPONDENT had complied with the financial disclosure requirement. Consequently, the Ethics Commission found that the public interest would not be served by proceeding further in this matter and granted the DEPUTY GENERAL COUNSEL’S Voluntary Motion to Dismiss.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The Ethics Commission may, at its discretion, discharge a COMPLAINT at any stage of disposition, as per the County Code at Sec. 2-1074 (s).


Therefore it is:
