**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

The Deputy General Counsel for the Commission on Ethics filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondent Frantz Telfort for allegedly violating the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (i)(1). Specifically, the complaint claimed that respondent failed to file a financial disclosure statement for the year 2010 while serving on the Miami-Dade County Small Business Enterprise Board. As a board member in 2010, complainant was required to file by July 1, 2011.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Sec. 2-1068, the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission extends "to any person required to comply with the County or municipal Code of Ethics Ordinances...." Sec. 2-11.1 (b) includes advisory board members within the authority of the County Ethics Commission.

On September 12, 2013, in public session, the Deputy General Counsel recommended that probable cause be found and the case be dismissed because respondent had complied with the financial disclosure requirement once he received adequate notice. The Ethics Commission agreed to dismiss the instant case against respondent.

Therefore it is:


  


**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that COMPLAINT C 13-20 against respondent Frantz Telfort is hereby concluded.
