PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

The Deputy General Counsel for the Commission on Ethics filed the above-referenced complaint against respondent Bruce Christensen for allegedly violating the Miami-Dade County Ethics Code at Sec. 2-11.1 (i)(1). Specifically, the complaint claimed that respondent failed to file a financial disclosure statement for the year 2012 while serving on the Coral Gables Green Task Force. As a board member in 2012, complainant was required to file by July 1, 2013.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Sec. 2-1068, the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission extends "to any person required to comply with the County or municipal Code of Ethics Ordinances...." Secs. 2-11.1 (a) and (b) of the County Ethics Code include municipal advisory board members within the authority of the County Ethics Commission.

On September 12, 2013, in public session, the Deputy General Counsel recommended that probable cause be found, the case be dismissed with prejudice, and respondent be assessed \$50 in investigative costs. Because respondent complied with the financial disclosure requirement once he received adequate

noticed, the Ethics Commission agreed to dismiss the instant case against respondent and assess investigative costs of \$50.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 13-21 against respondent Bruce Christensen is hereby concluded.
