PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Marie Soeurette Eloi (Eloi) filed the above-referenced complaint against respondent Michelle Dunaj Lucking (Lucking), Chairwoman of the Miami-Dade County Commission for Women (M-D CFW). The complaint alleged that respondent violated the M-D CFW by-laws as well as the Florida Sunshine Law, by and in the manner in which, she dismissed Eloi from serving on the M-D CFW.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Secs. 2-1068 and 2-11.1 (a), the Ethics Commission is empowered to enforce the County and municipal Code of Ethics ordinances. The Ethics Commission is not empowered to enforce the by-laws of Miami-Dade County boards or the Florida Sunshine Law, however.

On October 10, 2013, in closed session, the Ethics Commission therefore dismissed the instant complaint and asked that it be referred to the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office who is empowered to enforce the Florida Sunshine Law.

Therefore it is:




ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 13-22 against respondent Michelle Dunaj Lucking is hereby dismissed.
