**PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER**

Deputy General Counsel for the COE filed the above-referenced complaint against respondent Nicoletta Canesi (Canesi), a registered lobbyist in the City of Miami Beach during 2012. Respondent was charged with violating Sec. 2-485(a) of the City of Miami Beach Code, for failing to file a lobbyist expenditure statement.

Pursuant to the Code of Miami Beach at Sec. 2-485(e), the Ethics Commission is empowered to enforce the above-referenced section of the Miami Beach Code.

On November 14, 2013, in closed session, Respondent did not contest the charge against her and agreed to enter into a Settlement Agreement with the Ethics Commission. Pursuant to that Agreement, Respondent will pay \$100 in investigative costs, and, in return, the Ethics Commission waived Respondent's \$500 fine. The Ethics Commission hereby enters the Final Settlement Agreement.

Therefore it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that COMPLAINT C 13-28 against Respondent Nicoletta Canesi is hereby concluded.
