PUBLIC REPORT AND FINAL ORDER

Jose Azze, a private citizen, filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondents, the entire City of Hialeah for allegedly mismanaging a contract between El Duke Sports Association, LLC and the City. Pursuant to the Code of Miami-Dade County at Sec. 2-1068, the jurisdiction of the Ethics Commission extends "to any person required to comply with the County or municipal Code of Ethics Ordinances...."

On November 14, 2013, in closed session, the Ethics Commission's Advocate recommended that the case be dismissed as not legally sufficient because the complaint failed to name any specific individual¹. In open session, the Ethics Commission voted unanimously to dismiss the instant case against all respondents.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that COMPLAINT C 13-32 against respondent the City of Hialeah is hereby concluded.
